



MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR LATENT PRINT EXAMINER TRAINEES

1 Education and Experience Requirements

1.1 Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university

or

1.2 Associate's degree or sixty college semester hours, plus two years job-related experience

or

1.3 High school diploma or equivalent, plus four years job-related experience

Examples of job related experience:

- Ten-print work
- AFIS ten-print or latent work
- Crime scene processing
- Crime scene photography
- Criminal investigation

1.4 By the year 2005, a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university is recommended to be the minimum education required for a latent print examiner trainee.
